The workshop builds on SAVI® (System for Analyzing Verbal Interactions). Using SAVI, we can distinguish communication behaviors that create noise from those that make clarity. In times of turbulence and change, communication becomes more challenging. Perhaps you recognize some of these – often frustrating - situations:

- Long meetings where no decisions are taken
- Complaints that absorb all energy without moving to solutions
- Challenging situations where you would like to respond but don't know what to say
- Ongoing loops of 'Yes-but'... that do not lead anywhere

In contrast to the above is communication that increases our problem-solving capacity, motivates us, and leaves us energized. This workshop will increase your ability to map out, diagnose and influence a conversation. Primarily you will learn to:

- Identify communication problems
- Recognize repetitive, unproductive communication patterns
- Intervene in and change unproductive communication patterns
- Understand how the way we communicate emotions impacts the climate and our ability to solve problems
- Take what people say less personally
